

AN AGREEMENT FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A SISTER CITIES RELATIONSHIP
between the
CITY of NASSAU, THE BAHAMAS
and the
CITY of NASSAU, GERMANY

Recognizing the significance of fostering international understanding, cooperation, and mutual benefit, Nassau, The Bahamas, and Nassau, Germany, hereinafter referred to as "the Cities," acknowledge the founding principles of Sister Cities International and thereby commit to the following:

- 1. **Cultural Exchange:** The Cities shall facilitate cultural exchanges encompassing arts, heritage, and education, encouraging dialogue and appreciation of each other's traditions, languages, and customs.
- 2. **Economic Development:** Recognizing the potential for economic growth through collaboration, the Cities shall explore opportunities for tourism exchange, trade, investment, and business partnerships, with a focus on sustainable development and innovation.
- 3. **Education and Youth Engagement:** The Cities shall encourage educational exchanges and youth programs to nurture future leaders and promote global citizenship, fostering empathy, tolerance, and inclusivity.
- 4. **Environmental Sustainability:** Committed to protecting the planet for future generations, the Cities shall share best practices and collaborate on initiatives to address environmental challenges, including climate change resilience and conservation efforts.

This Sister City Agreement shall be officially established and shall become effective when this document has been duly executed by both parties and shall remain in effect indefinitely. Any amendment to this agreement shall be made, by mutual consent of both Cities in writing.
